Principally Junk

Materials: Collect into a bag or box about 20-30 small items from around your house, barn, tack room, whatever. Have a copy of the Leave No Trace 7 Principles available.

Directions: First, let everyone in the group pick out one item from the collection. Then post up or share a copy or copies of the Leave No Trace 7 Principles. Each person is to quietly decide which principle relates to their item and why. Then go about the room so that everyone can share their thoughts on their item. See if all 7 principles can be covered.

Or

Lay out all the items in a tray or on a table. Divide the group into teams of 3-4. Give each team a copy of the 7 Principles then have them choose 7 items from the collection. Each item should have a connection to one of the principles. Have each team write down those connections for each item they chose, then share with the rest of the group.
